Recruiting authority: Department of Revenue, Ministry of Finance

The Directorate of Enforcement plans to fill 9 posts of Assistant Legal Adviser on deputation or absorption. Serving government and some other public sector officers can be forwarded.

Vacancies: 9

Education: Law degree and 3 years as an Advocate dealing with criminal or fiscal laws, or a Master's degree in law and 1 year as an Advocate dealing with criminal or fiscal laws

Age limit: Not more than 56 years

Location: New Delhi

Salary or pay level: Level 11 (Rs 67,700 to Rs 2,08,700), plus 20% Special Incentive Allowance on basic pay

Posts

- Assistant Legal Adviser of Enforcement

Who can apply and the conditions

- Deputation or absorption. Eligible officers are those of the Central Government, State Governments, Union Territories, recognised universities or research institutions, PSUs or statutory or autonomous bodies. Only Central or State Government and Union Territory officers can be considered for absorption.
- Officers holding an analogous post on a regular basis, or with 5 years of regular service in Level 10, or equivalent.
- Law degree with 3 years as an Advocate dealing with criminal or fiscal laws, or a Master's degree in law with 1 year in the same work.
- Age not more than 56 years on the last date. Deputation should ordinarily not exceed four years.
- The Department of Revenue vacancies page lists 22 October 2026 as the last date.

Selection process

- Applications are screened by the department. The circular does not describe a written test.

How to apply

1. Officers who are eligible send the application in the annexed proforma through their cadre controlling authority to the Director, Enforcement Directorate, Pravartan Bhawan, Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam Road, New Delhi 110011.
2. The circular and proforma can also be downloaded from dor.gov.in/vacancies.
3. The circular asks that applications reach the Directorate within 45 days of publication in Employment News.

Documents

- Application in the prescribed proforma, forwarded through the cadre controlling authority
- Vigilance clearance and integrity certificate
- Attested copies of ACRs or APARs for the last five years
