Deputy Director of Enforcement, Directorate of Enforcement, on deputation

Recruiting authority: Department of Revenue, Ministry of Finance

The Directorate of Enforcement plans to fill 63 posts of Deputy Director on deputation. The circular stays valid from August 2026 to July 2027. Only serving government and public sector officers can be forwarded.

Location: Offices of the Directorate of Enforcement across India (including Mumbai and Nagpur)

Salary or pay level: Level 11 (Rs 67,700 to Rs 2,08,700), plus 20% Special Incentive Allowance on basic pay

Posts

- Deputy Director of Enforcement

Who can apply and the conditions

- Deputation for officers of All India Services, Central Services, Central or State Governments (including police), Union Territories, CBI, Reserve Bank of India or Public Sector Banks. Special grade rules apply for RBI and bank officers, see the circular.
- Officers holding an analogous post on a regular basis, or with 5 years of regular service in Level 10 (or equivalent).
- Bachelor's degree and 5 years of experience in intelligence, investigation, legal work, adjudication or prosecution on fiscal or banking matters, or in accounts or audit.
- Applications are accepted through August 2026 to July 2027 under this circular. The Department of Revenue vacancies page shows 31 July 2027 as the end date.

Selection process

- Applications are screened by the department. The circular does not describe a written test.

How to apply

- Officers who are eligible send the application in the annexed proforma through their cadre controlling authority to the Joint Director (Estt.), Directorate of Enforcement, Block-A, Pravartan Bhawan, Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam Road, New Delhi 110011.
- The circular and proforma can also be downloaded from dor.gov.in/vacancies.
- The circular is valid from August 2026 to July 2027 and applications received in this period are considered as vacancies arise.

Documents

- Application in the prescribed proforma, forwarded through the cadre controlling authority
- Vigilance clearance and integrity certificate
- Attested copies of ACRs or APARs for the last five years
