Education: Store Keeper Grade II: 12th pass and 1 year of stores experience.; Engine Driver: Matric and an Engine Driver competency certificate.; Lascar: Matric and 3 years of boat service.; Civilian Motor Transport Driver: 10th pass, heavy and light vehicle licence, and 2 years of driving.; MTS (Peon) and MTS (Chowkidar): Matric and 2 years of experience as office attendant or chowkidar.

Age limit: 18 to 25, 27 or 30 years, depending on the post

Location: Mumbai, Maharashtra

Salary or pay level: Level 1 to Level 4 of the pay matrix, depending on the post

Who can apply and the conditions

- Store Keeper Grade II: 12th pass and 1 year of stores experience. Age 18 to 25.
- Engine Driver: Matric and an Engine Driver competency certificate. Age 18 to 30.
- Lascar: Matric and 3 years of boat service. Age 18 to 30.
- Civilian Motor Transport Driver: 10th pass, heavy and light licence, and 2 years of driving. Age 18 to 27.
- MTS (Peon): Matric and 2 years as office attendant. Age 18 to 27.
- MTS (Chowkidar): Matric and 2 years as chowkidar. Age 18 to 27.

Selection process

- Scrutiny of applications, document verification and biometric check.
- Written test of 80 multiple choice questions in 1 hour (general knowledge, maths, English and trade questions). Qualifying marks are 50%, and 45% for SC and ST.
- Trade test where applicable.

1. Fill the application in the Annexure-I format given with the notice.
2. Attach self-attested copies of documents and a self-addressed envelope with a Rs 50 stamp.
3. Send it by ordinary post to HQ Coast Guard Region (West), Malabar Hill, Mumbai 400006, so that it reaches by 3 November 2026.
