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Post Matric Scholarship to OBC Students

Monthly maintenance allowance and fee support for OBC students in post matric courses in Maharashtra, if the parents' or guardian's income is up to Rs 2.50 lakh a year.

What you may get

Monthly maintenance allowance depends on the course group. Group A: Rs 425 for hostellers and Rs 190 for day scholars. Groups B and C: Rs 290 and Rs 190. Group D: Rs 230 and Rs 120. Group E: Rs 150 and Rs 90. A student in a government hostel gets one third of the hosteller rate. It is paid from the admission month if you are admitted on or before the 20th, otherwise from the next month. Tuition fee and exam fee are paid in full in government and aided institutions and at 50 percent in non government and unaided institutions. For girls the portal says 100 percent benefit applies as per the GR of 8 July 2024.

Who it is for

OBC students of Maharashtra in a government approved post matric course, whose parents or guardians earn up to Rs 2.50 lakh a year.

Main conditions

- Belongs to the OBC category and is a resident of Maharashtra
- Parents' or guardian's yearly income up to Rs 2.50 lakh
- A government approved course after class 10. For professional courses, admission through the CAP round is needed.
- At least 75 percent attendance in the current year.
- Any number of girls can get the scholarship, and at most two boys of the same parents.
- No scholarship is paid from the date you accept another scholarship or stipend.
- Must have passed the previous year's exam to renew
- Renewal, Group A courses: if you fail the exam for the first time the award may be renewed. After a second or later failure you bear your own expenses until you are promoted.
- Renewal, Group B, C, D and E courses: you must be promoted to the next class.
- If a medical condition or an unforeseen event stops you from sitting the annual exam, the head of the institution can certify that you would have passed, if satisfied by proof.

Documents

- Caste certificate from the Government of Maharashtra (also counted as proof of residence)
- Income certificate or income declaration from the competent authority
- Caste validity certificate (compulsory for professional degree and professional postgraduate courses, not for non professional courses)
- HSC or SSC marksheet, or the marksheet of the last exam
- Gap certificate (only if there is a gap in your studies)
- Death certificate of the father or guardian, if applicable
- Ration card, to show the number of children in the family
- Leaving certificate
- Declaration of the parents or guardians about the number of children who get the benefit
