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National Fellowship and Scholarship for Higher Education of ST Students (Scholarship, formerly Top Class Education for ST)

Scheduled Tribe students admitted to notified premier institutes may get help with fees and other costs.

What you may get

Tuition and admission fee and other non-refundable charges up to Rs 2.5 lakh a year per student, and Rs 5,000 a year for books, as stated in the guidelines.

Who it is for

ST students with family income up to Rs 6 lakh a year admitted on merit to a notified institute.

Main conditions

- Family income up to Rs 6 lakh a year from all sources.
- Admission on merit to an institute notified by the Ministry.
- Management quota admissions are not eligible.

How to apply

1. Register on the National Scholarship Portal (scholarships.gov.in) and get the One Time Registration number.
2. Fill the online form for this scheme and upload the documents.
3. Submit before the last date shown on the portal. The institute then verifies the form.
