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Rashtriya Vayoshri Yojana (RVY)

A central scheme that may give free physical aids and assisted living devices to senior citizens with age related problems.

What you may get

Free devices such as those for low vision, hearing impairment, loss of teeth and locomotor disability. The cost of generic devices is limited to Rs 15,000 per person and special items to Rs 20,000. One year of free maintenance is provided.

Who it is for

Senior citizens aged 60 years or more who are BPL or have monthly income up to Rs 15,000, and have an age related disability.

Main conditions

- Age 60 years or above.
- BPL category, or monthly income from all sources not above Rs 15,000.
- Aadhaar or Aadhaar enrolment slip, or another specified identity document.
- Medical officer certificate for the disability where needed.

Documents

- Aadhaar card or enrolment slip
- BPL ration card, or income certificate, or proof of old age pension under IGNOAPS or a state pension
- Medical officer certificate for the disability
