Startup India (DPIIT recognition)

Startups can apply for DPIIT recognition on the Startup India portal. Recognised startups may get some benefits.

What you may get

May include self-certification for some labour and environmental laws, 80% rebate on patent filing fees, income tax exemption for 3 years out of the first 10, easier winding up, and public procurement relaxations.

Who it is for

Eligible startups registered as a company, partnership firm, LLP or cooperative society.

Main conditions

- Within 10 years of incorporation (20 years for deeptech).
- Turnover under Rs 200 crore (Rs 300 crore for deeptech).
- Original and innovative business.
